### Suggested Itinerary

#### Day 1 Singapore – Perth (Meals on board)

Depart at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Perth. You may pick up your car at the airport.

#### Day 2 Perth – Fremantle – Mandurah

(Travel time : approx 1.5hrs)

Travel to Fremantle, situated at the mouth of the Swan River, Fremantle is a vibrant port city. It is a charming multi-cultural city with the best preserved example of 19<sup>th</sup> century port streetscape in the world. It is also a shopaholic’s heaven for crafts, clothes, jewellery, food and curious in the bustling Fremantle market. If time permits, may travel slight further to Rockingham, take a ferry to nearby Penguin island, it is fascinating to watch these adorable birds as they waddle along the beach.

Continue your journey south to Mandurah, there are some great cafes along the foreshore and you can spend the rest of your day at the Mandurah Ocean Marina where many million dollars boats are moored.

#### Day 3 Mandurah – Bunbury – Busselton

(Travel time : approx 3hrs)

This morning, leave for Bunbury to Koombana Bay with a cruise along the canals lines with opulent houses and the picturesque estuary, home to many migratory birds and friendly bottlenose dolphins. Bunbury is a cosmopolitan regional city that is full of life and offers a diverse range of holiday experiences. Afternoon continue the short drive to Busselton, is best known for its 144 year old jetty measuring 1841 meters. The jetty is the longest wooden structure in the South Hemisphere. The picture postcard resort town of Busselton lies sheltered on the sweeping shores of pristine Geographne Bay. Its crystal blue waters and 30 kilometers of dazzling, white sandy beaches stretching away towards cape Naturaliste.

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#### **Day 4 Busselton – Margaret River – Pemberton**

(Travel time : approx 1.5hrs)

After breakfast, travel onto the world-renowned Margaret River wine region. Some of the most picturesque scenery is found here, incorporating towering forest, a diverse coastline and lush green pasture that become a blaze of colour with wildflowers in Spring. A visit to the region would not be complete without exploring and tasting the wines from premium producers, may try at Xanadu winery or Voyager Estate and indulge in a vineyard lunch overlooking continuous rows of vines. Also not to be missed taste the local cheese, chocolates and yoghurts as you go. There after continue to Pemberton.

#### **Day 5 Pemberton – Walpole - Albany**

(Travel time : approx 3.15 hrs)

Pemberton adjoins the Gloucester National Park, with its towering karri trees and clear rivers. The Dave Bicentennial Tree is a dizzying 75m high, and the Gloucester Tree towers 61m above the forest surrounding Pemberton. Visitors can climb to the cabin for the sensational views of Karri Forest. Embark on an 4WD adventure ride on Yeagerup Dunes near Pemberton. Or visit the local marron, A fresh water crayfish that provides a unique gourmet treat. Stop at Walpole Wilderness Discovery Centre, learn the sites of The Valley of the Giants Tree Top Walk, Swarbrick and Mount Frankland. Continue travel to pristine coastal town of Albany for overnight.

#### **Day 6 Albany – Farmstay**

(Travel time : approx 2hrs)

This morning, be photographed at the nature wonders like the rugged costal cliffs and rock formations at The Gap, Natural Bridge and Blowholes. Other things to do such as the Sandalwood Factory, Whale World and Wind Farm. Move on to Kojonup, the “Farmstay Capital of Western Australia”, the rural town offers visitors the opportunity to spend time partaking in farm activities such as feeding animals, collecting eggs and catching yabbies. Tonight, experience the rural stay with the locals.

#### **Day 7 Farmstay - Perth**

(Travel time : approx 3.45hrs)

After bid farewell to the farm hos. Do visit the Kodja Place Interpretive Centre and experience Kojonup’s history which showcases local indigenous heritage and culture. Then, head back north and back to Perth city. Evening, may explore the bustling nightlife or find Many eateries from various cuisine at Northbridge. Or may try your fortune luck by visiting to Burswood Casino.
