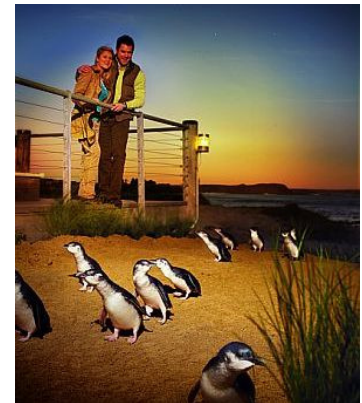

Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 Singapore – Melbourne (Meals on board)
Depart at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Melbourne.

Day 2 Melbourne
Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Free at leisure for you to explore the city, to visit fun-filled family attraction like Melbourne Museum, Melbourne Aquarium, Observation Deck and the Eureka Skydeck. For romance experience you may go on a City Circle Tram or a ride on the back of Harley to explore the city’s attractions and historical landmarks. Discover the allure of mega mall like Melbourne Central and QV or hidden laneways like Little Collins St and Flinders Lane.

Day 3 Melbourne – Philip Island
(Travel time : approx 1.30hrs)
This morning, pick up your car and head down to Philip Island, favorite destination for lovers of nature . On the way make a stop at Warrook Cattle farm to enjoy a true Aussie working farm experience. Short drive later, brief stop at Chocolate Factory opportunity to buy and view the manufacturing process. There after, proceed to Nobbies Centre, enjoy seal viewing with high-tech cameras and walk the boardwalk to the stunning blowhole. End the day with highlight to see nightly parade of little penguins returning from the sea to their burrows on Philip Island.

Day 4 Philip Island – Mornington Peninsula

(Travel time : approx 2hrs)

May start the day at Ryhill Fishing Park set on a seaside village where is renowned of 'trophy trout lake'. Come face to face with Koalas from treetop boardwalks at Koala Conservation Centre. Kids may be fascinated by world of optical illusions, mazes and puzzles at Amaze N Things. Continue drive along coastline to picturesque Mornington Peninsula. At Sunny Ridge Strawberry Farm, be indulged in delectable strawberry ice cream, wine, jam with scones and cream. May pick seasonal fresh berries (Nov to Apr). Rejuvenate the soothing waters of Peninsula Hot Springs.

Day 5 Mornington Peninsula – Melbourne

(Travel time : approx 2 hrs)

This morning, be fun-filled and have fun getting lost in Australia's largest hedge maze - Ascombe Maze and journey into a world of lavender in their Lavender Gardens. Other soft adventure activities include a boat cruise to spot for dolphins and Seals (Oct to May) or enjoy horse rides along the beach. Wine lover may enjoy a meal paired with estate-grown wines at the restaurant that's inspired by produce of the estate, many of which offer spectacular views of the rolling vineyards. At night in Melbourne city try your luck at Crowne Casino.

Day 6 Melbourne – Singapore (Meal on board)

This morning, do visit Queen Victoria market for some souvenir hunting and local fresh produce. If time permits, may want to do last minute shopping at Swanston Mall where you could find most big department store like Myers, David Jones & etc. Bid farewell and drop your car at airport and get ready for your departure flight home.
