Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 Singapore – Melbourne (Meals on board)
Depart at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Melbourne.

Day 2 Melbourne

Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Free at leisure for you to explore the city, to visit fun-filled family attraction like Melbourne Museum, Melbourne Aquarium, Observation Deck and the Eureka Skydeck. For romance experience you may go on a City Circle Tram or a ride on the back of Harley to explore the city’s attractions and historical landmarks. Discover the allure of mega mall like Melbourne Central and QV or hidden laneways like Little Collins St and Flinders Lane.

Day 3 Melbourne – Torquay - Apollo Bay

(Travel time : approx 3.15hrs)

Drive from Melbourne via the West Gate Bridge and follow the Princess Highway towards Geelong. The historic Werribee Park mansion and Point Cook National Aviation Museum are both accessible from the Highway. Spend sometime at Geelong, Victoria’s second largest city. Breathtaking views of Port Philip Bay can be seen from the “Rip” lookout at Point Lonsdale and from here is a short drive to Torquay, where the Surfworld Museum documents surfing history in the region. You may shop for discounted goods like Quiksilver, Billabong and Ripcurl at surfwear factory outlet. Continue the townships of Anglesea and Airleys inlet to Lorne, a resort-style town combining restaurants and shops. Leaving Lorne for Apollo Bay, popularly known as Paradise By The Sea.
Accommodation: Comfort Inn the International, Apollo Bay

Day 4 Apollo Bay – Port Campbell - Warrnambool

(Travel time : approx 2.30hrs)

Drive along the Great Ocean Road past rugged cliffs and rolling farmlands. Lavers Hill onward is a highlight, it traces limestone cliffs along the Shipwreck Coast, the limestone formations have been carved away from the mainland over thousands of years. These natural monuments form a stunning panorama and are a part of the Port Campbell National Park, highlights include the Twelve Apostles, Loch Ard Gorge and London Bridge.
Accommodation: The Sebel Deep Blue, Warrnambool



Day 5 Warrnambool – Farmstay (Dinner)

(Travel time : approx 1.15hrs)

Travel along A1 highway, bypassing townships like Terang, Camperdown, and onwards to Darlington/Ballarat – a living memorial to the Victorian gold rush of the 1850s. Be overwhelmed by an unforgettable memory to experience Aussie hospitality. Amidst the rural environment, indulge in farm activities such as milk cowing, collecting chicken eggs, horse grooming and fruits or vegetables picking if in season. The farm activities are vary depending on farm host.

Accommodation: Aussie Hospitality - Farmstay

Day 6 Farmstay – Melbourne (Breakfast)

(Travel time : approx 2hrs)

Bid farewell to farm host. You may visit Sovereign Hill, step back in time and experience the setting and atmosphere of the goldfields at Sovereign Hill – outdoor living museum. Or you may visit Ballarat Wildlife Park where you will meet the lovely local native Koala, Kangaroo and more. At evening, try your luck at Crowne Casino at Melbourne city.

Accommodation: Mercure Swanston Hotel or similar class

Day 7 Melbourne – Singapore (Meal on board)

This morning, do visit Queen Victoria market for some souvenir hunting and local fresh produce. If time permits, may want to do last minute shopping at Swanston Mall where you could find most big department store like Myers, David Jones & etc. Bid farewell and drop your car at airport and get ready for your departure flight home.
