



## Optional Tours - Phnom Penh

*Private tours include private round-trip transfers with English-speaking guide and entrance fees for all sightseeing featured in itinerary.*

### 1) Full-day tour with local buffet lunch included - Price per adult @ S\$99 / per child @ S\$79

#### **Morning**

- **National Museum** - red building with beautiful Khmer architecture and contains more than 5000 art objects made of sandstone, bronze, silver, copper, wood and others
- **Royal Palace** - built in 1866 by King Norodom, a colorful Khmer-style palaces
- **Silver Pagoda** (*otherwise known as The Emerald Buddha temple*) displaying plenty of Buddha Statues that were decorated and made by diamond, emerald, gold and silver

#### **Buffet lunch at Tonle Bassac Restaurant**

#### **Afternoon**

- **Toul Sleng Genocidal Museum and Choeng Ek Killing field.**  
Prior to 1975, Toul Sleng was a high school by under the Khmer Rouge it was converted into a prison and interrogation facility. Inmates were systematically tortured to extract confessions and then were killed at killing fields of Choeng Ek
- **Russian market** for shopping (*antiques, souvenirs, etc*)

### 2) Half-day shopping tour – Price per adult @ S\$59 / per child @ S\$48

- **Toul Sleng Genocidal Museum and Choeng Ek Killing field.**  
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- **Russian market or Central Market** - a lively outdoor market where you'll find antiques, silver and gold jewelry, gems, silk, Miniature Buddha, Apsara, as well as T-shirts, CDs, and other souvenirs

- *Morning tour starts from 0800am to 1200pm // Afternoon tour starts from 1430pm to 1800pm*

### 3) Half-day cultural tour – Price per adult @ S\$69 / per child @ S\$56

- **Wat Phnom Daun Penh** - pagoda built in 1373 to house Buddhist relics washed ashore by the river
- **Royal Palace** - built in 1866 by King Norodom, a colorful Khmer-style palaces
- **Silver Pagoda** (*otherwise known as The Emerald Buddha temple*) displaying plenty of Buddha Statues that were decorated and made by diamond, emerald, gold and silver
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
