**DAY 01 SINGAPORE / DELHI**  
**Flight Details: SQ 408 1905 / 2210**

**(Meal on Board)**

Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport for your flight to Delhi on board Singapore Airlines.  
Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

**DAY 02 DELHI / AGRA**

**(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)**

Your city tour of Delhi includes, driving past **Old Delhi**, the **India Gate**, **Parliament Gate** and a visit to **Qutub Minar**. Qutub Minar, one of the most perfect towers in the world, nearby amidst the ruins of Quwat-ul-Eslam mosque, stands the Iron Pillar which does not rust.

After lunch, continue to Agra. Enroute visit the lotus shaped **Bahai Temple**. Completed in 1986, it is set among pools and gardens and adherents of any faith are free to visit the temple and pray or mediate silently according to their own religion.

**DAY 03 AGRA**

**(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)**

Visit one of the Seven Wonders of the World, **Taj Mahal** this morning. Described as the most extravagant monument ever built for love, this poignant Mughal mausoleum has become the de facto tourist emblem of India. This monument made of pure white marble, was built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved Queen Mumtaz Mahal has taken over 22 years to build. Next stop is **Agra Fort**. The Agra Fort with its red sandstone walls dominated the city of Agra. It is here that the Emperor Shah Jahan spent the rest of his life imprisoned, looking out along the river of the final resting place of his wife.

Afternoon is free for some shopping.

Note : Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays.

**DAY 04 AGRA / JAIPUR**

**(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)**

This morning drive 6 hours to **Jaipur**, capital of Rajasthan, widely known as Pink City as it was color washed pink to welcome Prince Albert, the consort of Queen Victoria of England who visited India in 1883 AD.

Enroute visit **Fatepur Sikri**, the deserted red sandstone phantom city. This deserted city was built by Emperor Akbar to celebrate the birth of his son.

**DAY 05 JAIPUR**

**(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)**

This morning set off for a tour of Jaipur. Drive past **Hawa Mahal**, Jaipur's signature building, a multi layered palace with a profusion of windows and stone screens built in 1799. The experience of visiting **Amber Fort** is one that cannot be easily described. Ride upon an elephant (subject to availability) to the former capital of the royals, set to the backdrop of wooded hills. The **City Palace** was the principal residence of the former ruling family and is known for its stunning architecture. It also houses a museum.

**DAY 06 JAIPUR / DELHI / SINGAPORE**

**(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)**

**Flight Details: SQ 407 2325 / 0735+1**

Return to Delhi this morning.

After lunch, spend time at Sarojini Nagar or Janpath for some great shopping. Rest of the day is free at leisure fill transfer to airport.
