#### BEPPU ▶

Beppu is Japan's onsen capital. This town in Oita prefecture has two kinds of onsen: the ones that offer a wide range of baths to be enjoyed and the ones for admiring, named 'the hells' (jigoku).

#### LAKE KINRIN

This is a small and beautiful lake just 400m in circumference. On cold winter mornings the lake is surrounded by mist rising and covering its surface. Its mysterious atmosphere and the play of light on the surroundings gives it an everchanging appearance when viewed from different angles.



#### HUIS TEN BOSCH ▲

Huis Ten Bosch was born on March 25, 1992 in Nagasaki Prefecture. Built after a 17th century Dutch town, Huis Ten Bosch means 'House in the Forest'. True to its name, this resort has canals running throughout, is surrounded by greenery, forests and has flowers in full bloom throughout the year.

#### KUMAMOTO CASTLE ▼

Built by Kato Kiyomasa in 1607, after seven years of construction, Kumamoto Castle is one of three most famous castles in Japan. Most of the castle's buildings, including the towers, were reconstructed. Several of the smaller wooden buildings, however, are original. Together, they reflect the grandeur of the castle during the Edo Period.



#### DAZAIFU TENMANGU ▲

Dazaifu Tenmangu is the first and most important of hundreds of shrines dedicated to Sugawara Michizane. An influential scholar and politician of the Heian Period, he is venerated by Japanese as Tenjin, the kami (Shinto God) of Education.

#### GLOVER GARDEN

This open air museum features the Western style residences of Nagasaki's former foreign residents. It included the residences of British merchants Frederick Ringer and William Alt as well as that of a Scottish merchant, Thomas Glover. Among the mansions, Glover Residence is the oldest Western style house surviving in Japan.

#### NAGASAKI ATOMIC BOMB MUSEUM

On August 9, 1945, at 11:02am an atomic bomb was dropped over Nagasaki. The Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Museum covers the history of this event as a story. It begins with scenes of the attack and includes the reconstruction of Nagasaki up to present day as well as the history of nuclear weapons development and the hope for a world free of such weapons.



#### MOUNT ASO ▲

Aso is the site of the world's largest volcano caldera, with a diameter of up to 25km and a circumference of over 100km. Lined with gently rolling, broad green grassy plains and ponds, over 80,000 people reside in the caldera. Mount Aso is an active volcano and its five mountain peaks are reputed to be among the world's most beautiful.

#### ARITA PORCELAIN PARK

Arita porcelain has fascinated European royalty and nobility from the 17th century and influenced the world of ceramics. Collections of Arita porcelain from the Edo to Meiji period are exhibited in the 'Zwinger', a reproduction representing 18th century German baroque architecture. Do not miss out the experience to create and bring home Arita porcelain.

#### YANAGAWA

Located near the mouth of Chikugogawa River, Yanagawa is known for its canals that were built years ago for irrigation. They are now plied by 'Donko', the Japanese version of a gondola, that take tourists on cruises around the city. Also of interest is a museum that displays the writings and drawings of Hakushu Kitahara, a Meiji era poet and writer of children's songs.

#### KARATSU CASTLE ▼

Built by Terazawa Hirotake in 1608, Karatsu Castle is also known as the 'Castle of the Soaring Crane', an image formed by the castle tower as the head and the pine groves to its left and right as the wings. Presently, the interior of the restored five-storey castle tower displays important exhibits from the feudal era.
