



4D3N Sights of Da Nang, Hoi An & Hue

Day 01 Singapore / Da Nang / Hoi An

(Dinner)

Assemble at Changi International Airport for your flight to **Da Nang**. Known as the commercial and educational center of Central Vietnam and the largest city here, be awed by one of the country's most important ports. Prepare for a private land transfer to **Hoi An** (*estimated 40 – 50 mins per way*) – where you will have your own free leisure time until dinner at a local restaurant. Rest for the night in a choice of your hotel.

Day 02 Hoi An / Da Nang / Hue

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast at the hotel, we take a walking tour in the ancient town of Hoi An to visit **former merchants' houses**, the 400-years **Japanese Covered Bridge** and the **Colorful Market**. After lunch at a local restaurant, prepare for a private land transfer to Hue (*estimated 3.5 – 4 hours per way*). Upon arrival in Hue, take a **boat trip** on the romantic **Huong River** (also known as Perfume River) to visit Hue's well-known religious site – **Thien Mu Pagoda** (or Heavenly Lady Pagoda) - one of the oldest and prettiest religious buildings in the country. After dinner at a local restaurant, rest for the night in a choice of your hotel.

Day 03 Hue / Da Nang

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast at the hotel, we visit **Khai Dinh King's Mausoleum** – a tomb of Western and Eastern architecture, located on a steep hill. Next is **Hue's Imperial Citadel** – made up of three 'courts' which was formerly the country's administrative centre, where the Nguyen Dynasty ruled between 1802 and 1945. After lunch at a local restaurant, its shopping at **Dong Ba Market**. We return to Da Nang (*estimated 3.5 – 4 hours per way by private land transfer*) and after dinner at a local restaurant, rest for the night in a choice of your hotel.

Day 04 Da Nang / Singapore

(Breakfast / Lunch)

After breakfast at the hotel, we visit **Cham Museum** – an old sandstone building which houses the largest collection of Cham art and sculptures, finds of the ancient Champa kingdom. Next, proceed to the **Marble Mountains** - five 'mountains' named after the five elements; Kim (metal), Thuy (water), Moc (wood), Hoa (fire) and Tho (earth). Its last-minute shopping at **Han Market** and lunch at a local restaurant, before transfer (*estimated 20 minutes per way*) to the airport for your returning flight home.
