Chitose Salmon Aquarium (Hour: 0900-1700)

Chitose Salmon Aquarium accommodates an underwater Observation room, the first of its kind in Japan, which allows you to see the true nature of the river and groups of salmon swimming up it to spawn in autumn.

Alpha Resort Tomamu

Ones can enjoy in this resort whereby the nature of Tomamu gets one to relax and forgets the bustle of the usual days. In this all in one resort it has the facilities like Spa House, Onsen, golfing and fine dining restaurants

Kushiro Marsh Observatory

In Kushiro, we will visit Japan's largest marshland, Kushiro Marsh. Stretches out over the majority of the Kushiro Plain.

Japanese Crane Reserve

Tsurui to Japanese Crane Sanctuary is a famous tourist spot where you can observe Japanese crane close at hand.

Lake Marsh

Lake Marsh is one of the world's most transparent lakes. The crater lake is slightly larger than Lake Akan and is surrounded by steep, awe inspiring and forbidding cities as high as 300 to 400 meters

Shiretoko Five Lakes

On the way to the refreshing Shiretoko Five Lakes, you will get to see one of Japan most beautiful and unspoiled national parks and home to a variety of wildlife. Stop at Oshinkoshin Falls, the fall flows alongside a road and drops magnificently towards the sea.

Lake Saroma

Lake Saroma, the largest lake in Hokkaido. The long straight sand bar that separates the Sea of Okhotsk from Lake Saroma is Ryugu-Kaido
