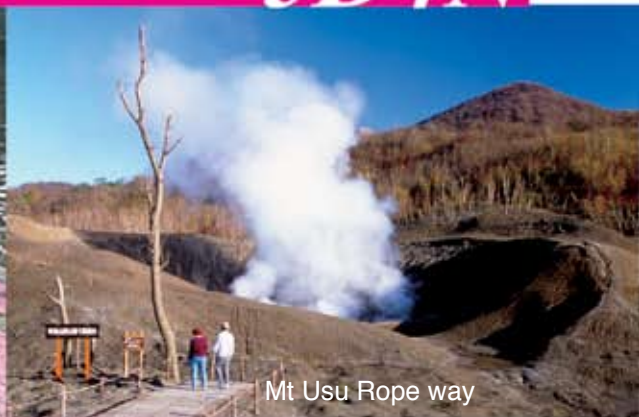

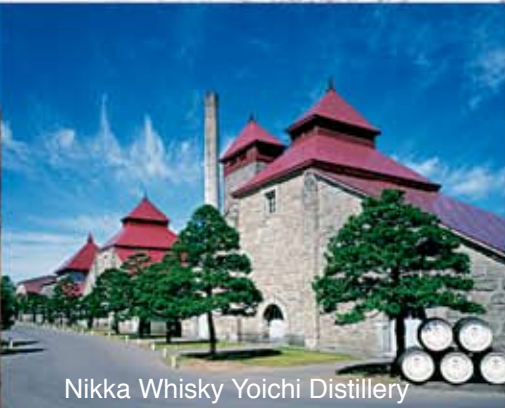

Nikka Whisky Yoichi Distillery



Drive the Lake Side and Mountain View Route

Enjoy outdoor activities with some of the most famous mountains in Hokkaido as the stage.

Lake Shikotsu

Many wild animals and alpine animals inhabit the lake, which luxuriant forests have long surrounded. Driving along the lakeside with continuous green tunnels and turns while viewing the clear blue water.

MT Showa Shinzan

This is another volcano that was formed as a result of rising farmland after two years of volcanic activities, between 1943 and 1945. Before the 1945 eruption, this area was nothing but flat farmland, however the raising of the ground resulted in the active volcano that you see today.

Mt Usu Ropeway

This active mountain also erupted in 1977, forming two new peaks rising out of the calderas lake. The most recent eruption formed several new peaks as well. Local residents know Mt. Usu lovingly as the "King of Volcanoes."

Rusutsu Resort

Rusutsu comprises a vast and comprehensive relaxation and recreation facility, complete with swimming pools, ski slopes, hiking trails, golf courses and a large amusement park. Not surprisingly, it is a popular destination for day trips among Sapporo residents in summer and winter.

Nikka Whisky Yoichi Distillery

Masataka enrolled at the University of Glasgow and became the first Japanese ever to study the art of whisky making. He took chemistry courses

at the university and apprenticed at distilleries, learning first-hand from craftsmen and receiving training as a blender. Masataka would later become known as a master blender. 1934 Masataka established Nikka Whisky, and built its first distillery in Yoichi, Hokkaido

Otaru Canal

Otaru Canal was created by filling in the ocean side in 1923. There used to be many bridges over the canal, which supported the golden days of commerce of Otaru. The canal was improved and is now a tourist spot.

Kitaichi Glass Museum

This is a long established store representative of Otaru, a city of glass. The coffee shop of Kitaichi Hall with 167 kerosene lamps illuminating the stone warehouses, is also a popular tourist spot.
